The Mango Papaya project is small scale partnership which aims to promote sustainable development, entrepreneurship competences and game based learning



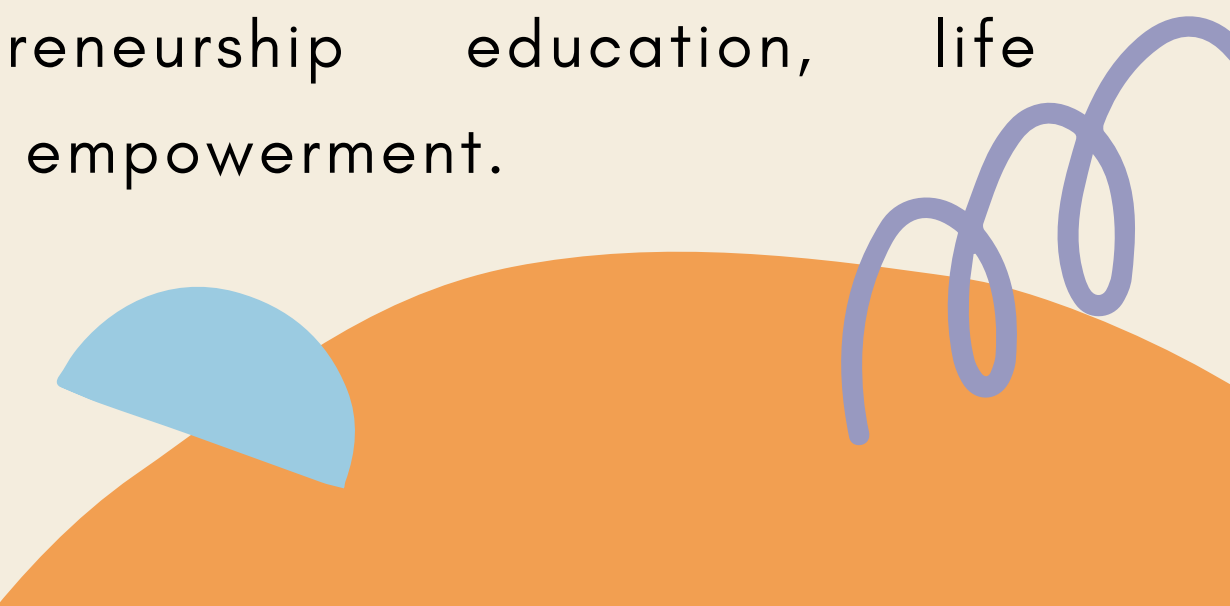

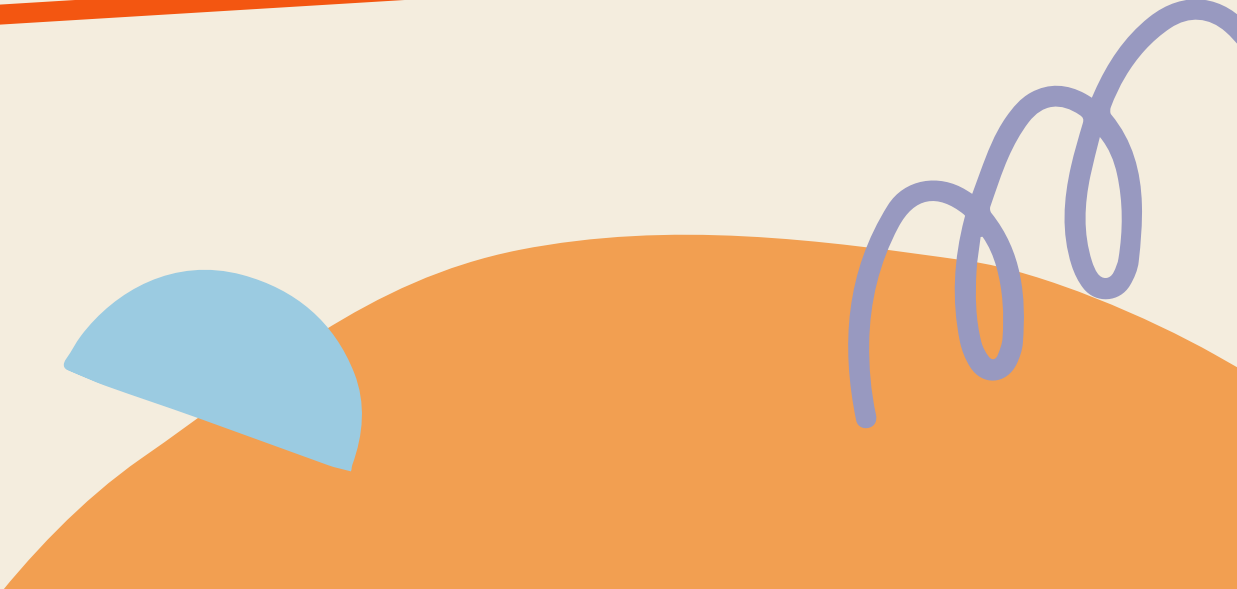

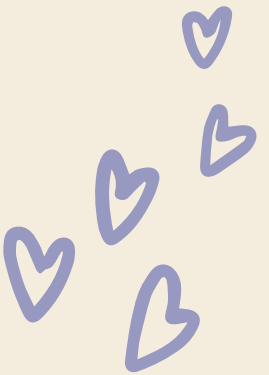
Erasmus+

Our goal



The goal of the project is to to develop methodology based on gamification for increasing the entrepreneurship competencies among youth and promote sustainable development.

To reach that we have a training course and development of the boardgame (which beside the board game and its actions combine interaction between players and impacts their actions in real life f.e. Some tasks from the game which they can do in real life to protect the environment).

The main pillars of the project are game based learning methodology, entrepreneurship and sustainable development.



Why ???

The part of sustainable development and the title Mango Papaya was designed to re-thing about our life-style, consumption and how it affects the environment and the people in other parts of the world. Bringing the example of the fruits, vegetables which are not produced in Europe but are in high demand imported from the countries of Global South where the human rights or employees rights are not ideal, or they do not exist at all.

Through this project & game we wanted to focus on brining this awareness of earning money (entrepreneurship part) but also thinking about the all elements which are involved like: environment which may be damaged by the transportation costs, plantations, people who are working in difficult or not safe environment, for low amount of money, or maybe even child labor or slavery.

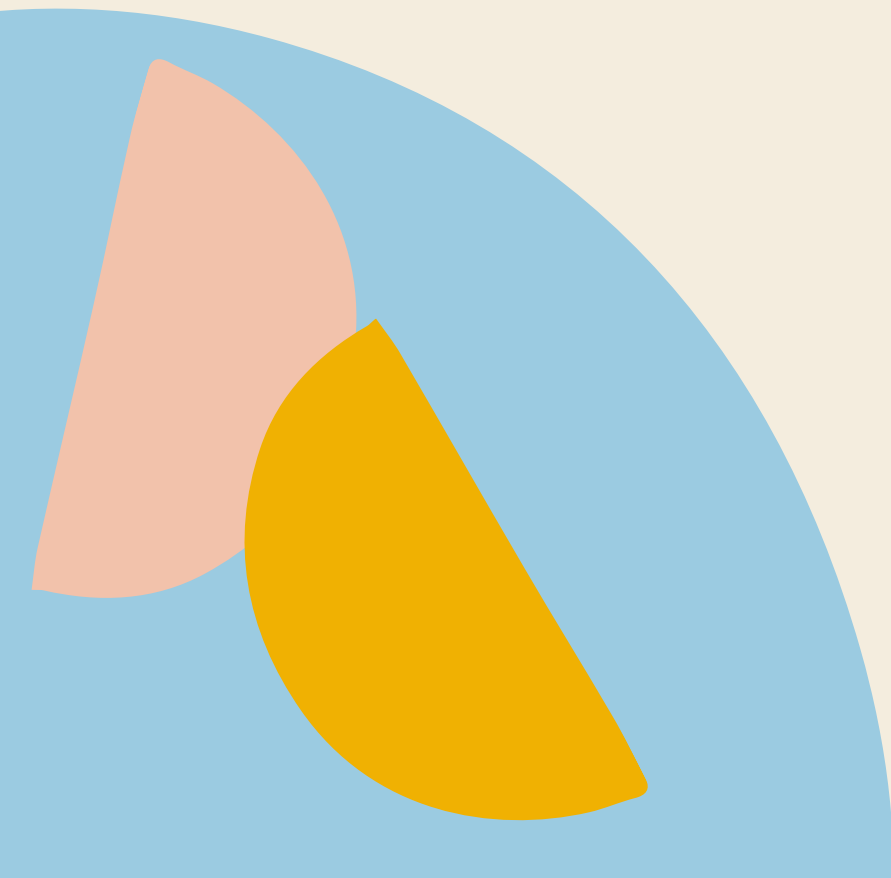
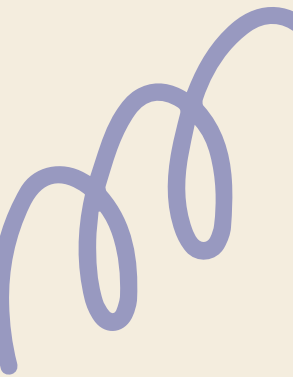


The project aims to increase the youth workers competences in the field of game based learning, entrepreneurship and sustainable development through non-formal education.

Objectives



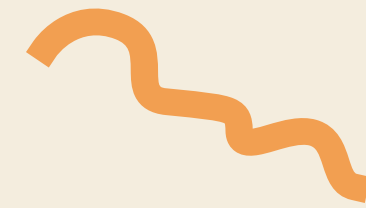
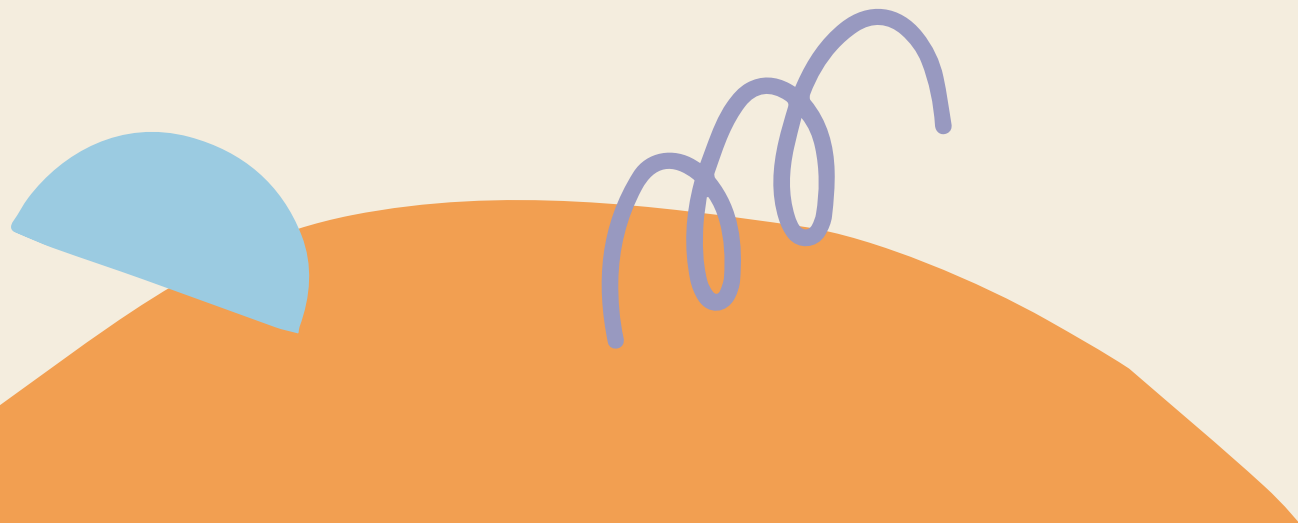
- increasing competences in field of sustainable development, entrepreneurship and game based learning

- communicative level of English
- age limit minimum 18 years old
- active youth workers, leaders daily working with youth
- motivation to experience NFE methodology
- motivation to take active part in all workshops during the activity

Methods

During the training participants will take part in the workshops based on non-formal educational approach, and competences based learning where participants will develop their competencies through gamify activities in field of sustainable development, entrepreneurship and they would learn how to design the educational board game through learning by doing.

Activities

Training course is designed for youth workers, where they would increase their competences in the field of game based learning, entrepreneurship and sustainable development through experiential learning.

The first part of the training course would be dedicated to development of youth workers competencies in the field of entrepreneurship education, sustainable development, game based learning and gamification. In the second part of the project there would be a creative process based on brainstorming aiming development of the educational board game.

Participants would develop the prototypes of the game which would be tested during the local phases.

In the evenings there would be space for participants to play and test diverse boardgames. So you can take your favourite games with you ;)

Daily there would be at least 6 hours of workshops and time for reflection. (everyday we will start workshops at 9:30 and finish around 19 o'clock, with 2 coffee breaks and lunch break).

Preparation



To get ready for the training course we would ask you to get familiar with the educational materials in field of: environment protection, sustainable development and entrepreneurship, which have been prepared by partners.

Venue

The training course will take place in Murzasichle the small town in the Tatra mountains, near Zakopane (the winter capital of Poland). Participants will stay in bedrooms (2-4 people in rooms) with bathrooms. All activities will take place in the workshop room in the next building. In the venue there would be a canteen which will provide the meals (breakfast, lunch, dinner) and coffee breaks.

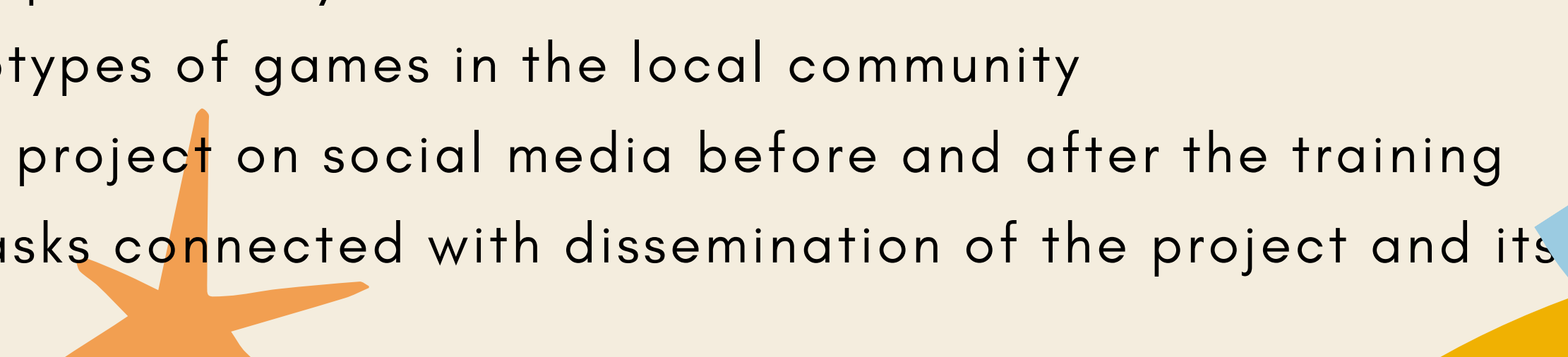
Living condition

Active participation

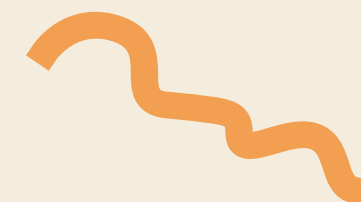
By taking part in this project, you are confirming that you are going to be active in all phases of the project:

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The dissemination of the project is one of our priorities. After the project participants are obligated to make follow up activities till the 20th of December. What requires preparation for those activities before the training.

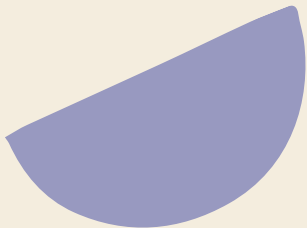


Follow up

Travel



Due to environmental protection we would recommend to lower the carbon emission during the travel (promote train/bus transportation, direct flights).

Selected participants could start to find a connection to Kraków. Please, send to us proposal of your travel (which includes travel company, time & date of arrival and departure, price), later you should wait for our confirmation to buy them. Tickets bought without our confirmation will be not reimbursed. More about the reimbursement process, in next section.

Tickets should be bought by low fare prices, only second class. You can come to Poland in total 2 days before or after the main activities, however we can not cover expenses of your venue and meals before or after the activities.

Travel - Arrival



On the 28th of November, we are going to meet around 18:30 o'clock near the main train station in Kraków. Then we will go with the shuttle bus to our venue (the cost of the shuttle bus will be reduced from the travel reimbursement limits). Plan your travel to be before 18 o'clock in Kraków. On the 5th of December we will leave our venue around 8 am, please plan your departure from Kraków after 12 o'clock.

The closest airports to Kraków are in Kraków, Katowice, Warsaw.


From those cities, you can take the train to Kraków (check out the schedule at: <http://rozkladpkip.pl/en>).



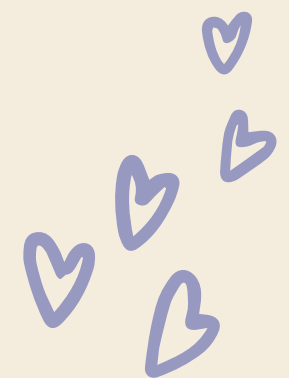
Reimbursement



The reimbursement of travel costs is managed by partners organisations separately. The maximum travel reimbursement is 245 euros (The travel limits are lower by 30 euro to provide the shuttle bus from and to Kraków to/from our venue in Murzasichle).



For Polish participants: please bring all of your original travel documents, including the tickets, receipts, bills and boarding passes. The reimbursement of the travel costs would be done via bank transfer after accomplishing all follow up activities.



COVID



Due to the unstable situation with COVID-19 it's OBLIGATORY to have a health insurance and travel insurance. Participants are themselves responsible to get a travel insurance.

If there's anyone who uses any kind of medications, they should bring them with themselves. We don't give any medicines and we don't cover insurance fees.

We hope that situation with COVID-19 will not affect our event and we all be meeting very soon.

During the Training Course we will take care of safety (e.g. fever measurements and usage of sanitizers) and follow the recommendations announced by Polish Ministry of Health, if any by that time. We would kindly ask participants to bring their individual protection (e.g. masks) and any other medicine they feel needed.

* I have not traveled internationally within the last 14 days.

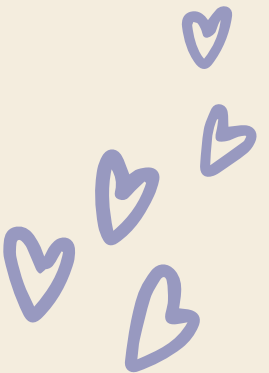
* I have not traveled to a highly impacted area within the last 14 days.
